



## COVID-19 SAFETY: What are we doing to keep you safe?

In addition to our regular hospital grade disinfection and sterilization protocols with biological monitoring, our team at All About Smiles has increased our measures due to Covid-19 to help keep our patients and staff safe. We have implemented more thorough cleaning and disinfection of all “high touch” surfaces throughout the day. Our point of sale terminals are covered in single use barriers for those instances when contact is not avoidable and those are changed and disinfected with medical grade disinfectant after each patient encounter. We have added the use of a disinfectant “fogger” to our daily routines and it now allows us to fog operatories to aid in extra disinfection after aerosol procedures and we also fog the entire office daily to keep our environment as clean and safe as possible. We have also purchased air filtration units for every single operatory and “common area” to increase air turnover in which air passes through a carbon filter, a HEPA filter and then a UVC disinfection light.

We are staggering appointments and asking all patients to remain in their car when they arrive until they have been screened again with our Covid-19 screening assessment questionnaire. After evaluation of that questionnaire, patients are then notified when our team is ready to accept their entry into the clinic. When you enter the clinic you may then expect to be asked to disinfect your hands with an alcohol based hand sanitizer and your temperature will be taken. All patients will then be asked to rinse with a 1% hydrogen peroxide rinse as soon as they are seated before any oral evaluation or treatment may be performed.

You may not be able to see our smiling, welcoming faces as we are covered under multiple masks, eye protection and surgical caps..... but we promise that we are still happy to see you and help you with your oral health needs!

We will continue to keep you updated as we all proceed through these “phases” of re-opening together. We are committed to providing care and services to our community.
